



Ontario Food Terminal

Attention All Buyers

New actions required as of March 25, 2020:

Screening and questioning at main entrance

- No entry if you have a cough, fever or difficulty breathing
- No entry if you have travelled internationally (except USA)
- No entry if you have been in close contact with an international traveler (except USA)

Stay in vehicle at all times while at Ontario Food Terminal (OFT)

- No entry to offices or warehouse spaces
- Tenants will bring the produce to your vehicle for you to load
- Leave your cab only to verify contents of produce received and for loading
- Emergency use of washroom permitted by exception only
- No use of dollies or “two wheelers”

Order ahead wherever possible

- Place your orders in advance
- If not possible, place your order by phone or digitally once you get to OFT

Electronic payments only

- Make arrangements with tenants for electronic payments, such as e-transfers

Reduce the spread of illness through preventive measures

What you can do to reduce the spread of illness:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are ill.
- Emphasize to your employees and buyers to stay home when they have a cough, fever, or have difficulty breathing.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then immediately throw the tissue in the garbage and wash your hands.
- If you don't have a tissue, sneeze or cough into your sleeve or arm.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Social distancing:

- Stay at least 2 metres away from other people wherever possible. No physical contact, like handshakes, permitted.
- Use disposable gloves and face masks when interacting with others if possible.

International travel:

If you have travelled internationally or have been in close contact with another person who has travelled internationally, except to the United States, you are not allowed on the Ontario Food Terminal property for 14 days after the date of return to Canada.

Stay informed:

The Terminal will remain open to continue to provide a safe and reliable food supply to the people of Ontario. We will modify our protocols as needed as COVID-19 evolves and update you on the actions we are taking.
