South Train Bay East End Docks /Compactor Waste Station and Cold Storage Receiving/Shipping Areas Construction

During the month of October, foundation and plumbing work will continue for the east end dock extension, new compactor station building and the original cold storage receiving/shipping dock extension. The contractor will begin construction on the new main OFT entrance way accessibility ramp, staircase and wall.



Ontario Food Terminal Roadways

All persons using the Terminal Roadways are reminded that the maximum speed limit for all vehicles is 15 km/h. All participants of the Ontario Food Terminal must follow the speed limit and obey stop signs and other rules of the road. Drivers who break speed limits not just put their own safety at risk but also pose threats to other OFT road users.

Always be aware of traffic around you as you drive. Develop a routine for looking ahead, behind and from side to side. Check your mirrors and check your blind spots by turning your head to look over your shoulder. This is especially true when driving around large vehicles.

Farmers' Market New Lighting Pilot Area

The Ontario Food Terminal Board is testing new lighting over stalls located at the west end of the 200—300 row. So far, the farmers in the area have provided positive feedback. These new led lights can potentially reduce energy consumption by 60% without sacrificing current light levels over the stalls.
